so words can kill people's physical life  
27:47  
literally even if they do not words can  
27:52  
harm people's inner life their souls and  
27:56  
spirits is there anything that has been  
27:59  
said to you is still distorting and  
28:03  
polluting the way you think of yourself  
28:06  
you can never be good enough no one  
28:09  
likes you  
28:10  
you saw worst kind harm us  
28:12  
psychologically because an old saying  
28:16  
says this we are not who we think we are  
28:21  
we are who we think other people think  
28:25  
we are  
28:25  
so our self-image is formed to some  
28:30  
extent by other people's thoughts and  
28:32  
words therefore words can hurt our inner  
28:37  
personal self  
28:39  
in addition words can do great harm to  
28:42  
relationships when I was a teenager for  
28:45  
many times just one sentence I said to  
28:48  
my parents

immediately change and deeply hurt my  
28:51  
relationship with them  
28:52  
the sentence is something like can you  
28:56  
stop talking do not bother me leave me  
28:58  
alone and just the one sentence and  
29:01  
within one second there would be  
29:03  
terrible silence in my family until I  
29:07  
apologized to them therefore one day I  
29:11  
said to myself resolutely next time when  
29:14  
you are unhappy and impatient and angry  
29:17  
shut your mouth up and do not say a word  
29:20  
and honestly the effects are not bad at  
29:24  
all we need to learn to shut our mouth

up and do not blurt out harmful words

why because words are like swords it can  
29:35  
penetrate into people's hearts and  
29:37  
actually words sometimes are even more  
29:41  
terrible than salt since physical wounds  
29:44  
often heal none before emotional ones

the wounds caused by words remain numb

after the words have faded away

it can barely be healed so please keep

should not speak and a third the

first the winter shut up 'la Bible  
30:32  
teaches we should not speak harmful  
30:34  
words to harm people however Bible never  
30:38  
says you should never speak up to create  
30:41  
his eyes and to make people feel hurt  
30:43  
nowadays many people are too sensitive  
30:45  
to criticism or even mild disagreement  
30:49  
they get hurt so easily you you of you  
30:52  
will find when you say to the members  
30:54  
from the LGBTQ groups  
30:56  
and you say to them homosexual allottees  
30:59  
saying transgender is saying they would  
31:01  
respond immediately you discriminate  
31:03  
against me I'm hurt by a word you do not  
31:06  
have love you hate me wow they are so  
31:09  
sensitive and authoritarian government  
31:12  
also hates any criticism any people and  
31:16  
will whenever any people speaks armed  
31:18  
and criticized and immediately  
31:20  
government would get angry and it would  
31:24  
command P command people to shut up  
31:28  
even some leaders in the church - the  
31:31  
same thing while they are confronted  
31:33  
about church members they say do not

31:36  
speak shut up  
31:37  
control your tongue look at Jesus he was  
31:40  
silent well he was suffered so when  
31:42  
we're not abuse you please shut up do  
31:46  
not criticize well here I'm not saying  
31:50  
you should never speak up criticize or  
31:52  
hate or hurt people sometimes we need to  
31:56  
hurt people but in order to have them  
31:59  
restored right here I'm saying that we  
32:02  
should not speak with the aim to harm  
32:05  
and to destroy people to know when to  
32:09  
shut up  
32:10  
we must examine our inward attitudes  
32:13  
before we speak if I speak up out of  
32:17  
hatred merely for hurting people or for  
32:21  
causing strife or out of the feeling of  
32:25  
superiority I should shut up so when you  
32:29  
shut up first when I speak out of hatred  
32:33  
what is hatred what a kind of failing  
32:36  
reviews you hit someone I was mentioned  
32:39  
that before proverbs 24 17 says this do  
32:43  
not rejoice when your enemy Falls and  
32:46  
let not your heart be glad when he  
32:48  
stumbles it indicates that if we hit  
32:51  
someone we would never single thighs  
32:55  
with them we would never weep together  
32:57  
with them when they are weeping rather  
33:00  
when they stumble when they are weeping

33:03  
when when they are not happy  
33:05  
we rejoice inside but when they stand  
33:09  
firmly they did not stumble  
33:10  
they are happy they're successful we are  
33:13  
unhappy this is the seed of hatred so  
33:18  
when you envy when you see people around  
33:20  
they are so happy because they are  
33:22  
popular good-looking they get promoted  
33:24  
you want to take away from them those  
33:28  
wonderful things you want you want them  
33:30  
to lose you do not want to see them to  
33:33  
be so happy therefore you want to see  
33:35  
something to harm them at that very  
33:38  
moment you should shut up for instance a  
33:42  
girl beside you is so popular on  
33:44  
Facebook she looks beautiful and all  
33:46  
your friends and classmates recommend  
33:48  
her and you are thinking inside why old  
33:52  
people like her why nobody focuses he's  
33:55  
all her attention on me I would tell  
33:58  
everybody how bad that girl actually is  
34:00  
if you have that intention your heart  
34:03  
you should shut up or will you want to  
34:06  
revenge your hurt by someone  
34:08  
therefore you hate him you want to swat  
34:10  
back and the most convenient way for us  
34:13  
to do so is to speak evil of him but  
34:17  
proverbs 24:29 says do not say I will do

34:22  
to him as he has done to me I will pay  
34:25  
the man back for what he has done if you  
34:28  
speak up merely out of revenge you  
34:32  
should shut your mouth up besides be  
34:37  
cautious when you are in anger  
34:39  
I'm not seeing here that you should  
34:42  
never speak up when you are angry  
34:44  
because in the Bible you can say Jesus  
34:46  
angrily rebuked Pharisees and he angrily  
34:50  
overturned their tables in the temple  
34:53  
however as I mentioned before the line  
34:57  
between the righteous anger and  
34:58  
unrighteous anger is so fine  
35:01  
so whenever you sense the elements of  
35:05  
resentment bitterness pride and malice  
35:09  
in your anger you are so-called  
35:11  
righteous anger you should shut up at  
35:14  
least at that very moment as those  
35:18  
sinful elements in your anger would hurt  
35:21  
people  
35:23  
so speak up after you calm down I heard  
35:27  
that some parents when they were
